Figure 1. A majority of NYC children ages 3-6 live in immigrant families





Figure 2. The origins of NYC children ages 3-6 in immigrant families span the globe






Figure 9. Nursery School and Preschool Enrollment Among Children Age 3 in Immigrant Families from Regions with Enrollment Rates Between 21-35 Percent
