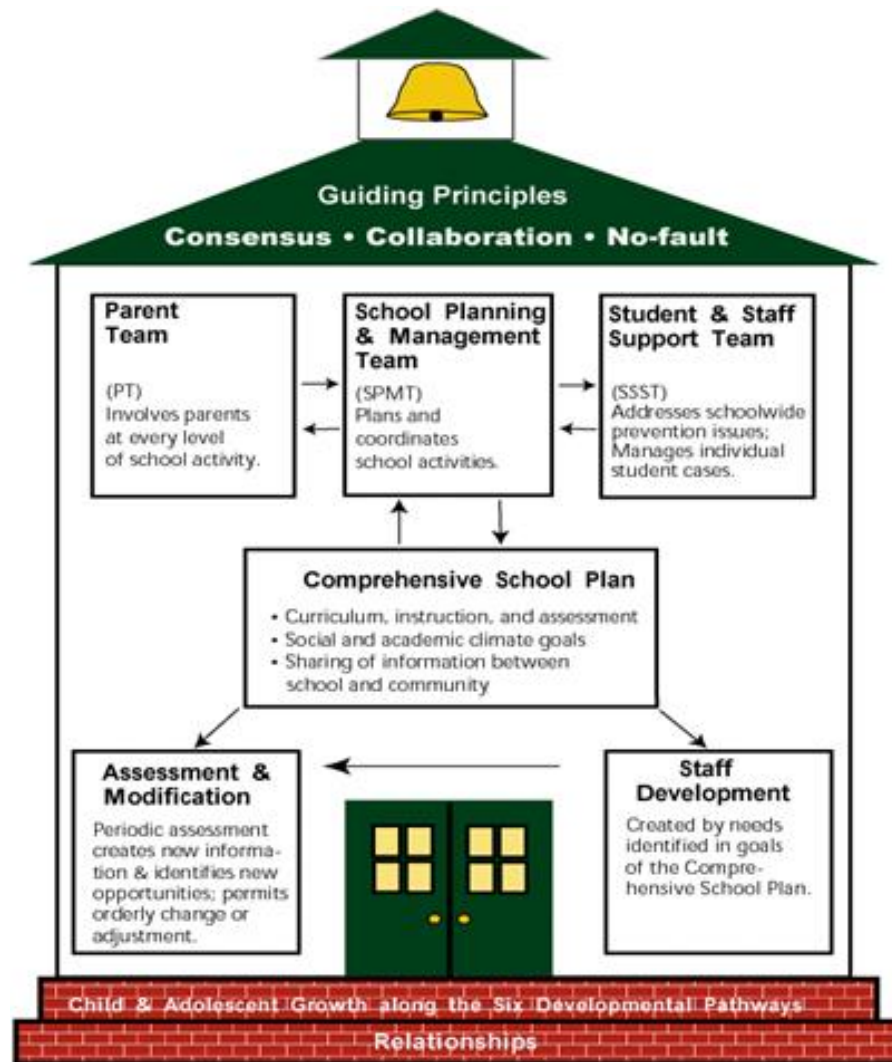

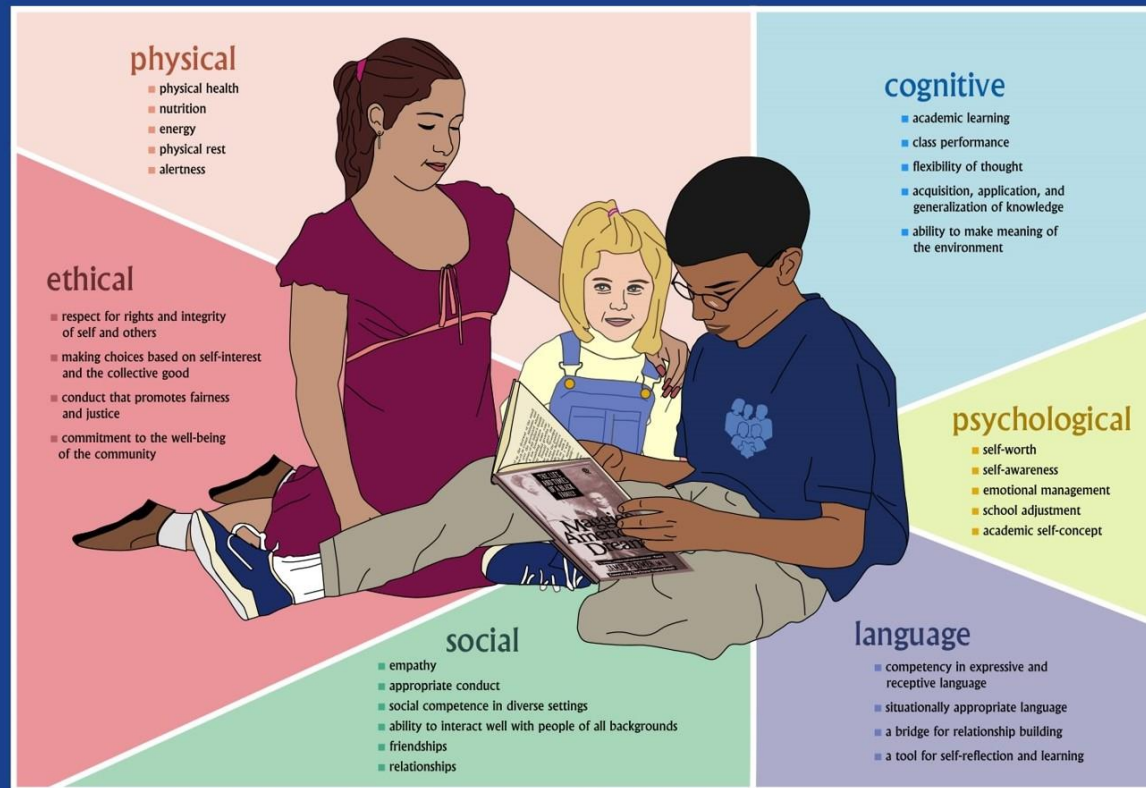
# Model of the SDP Process



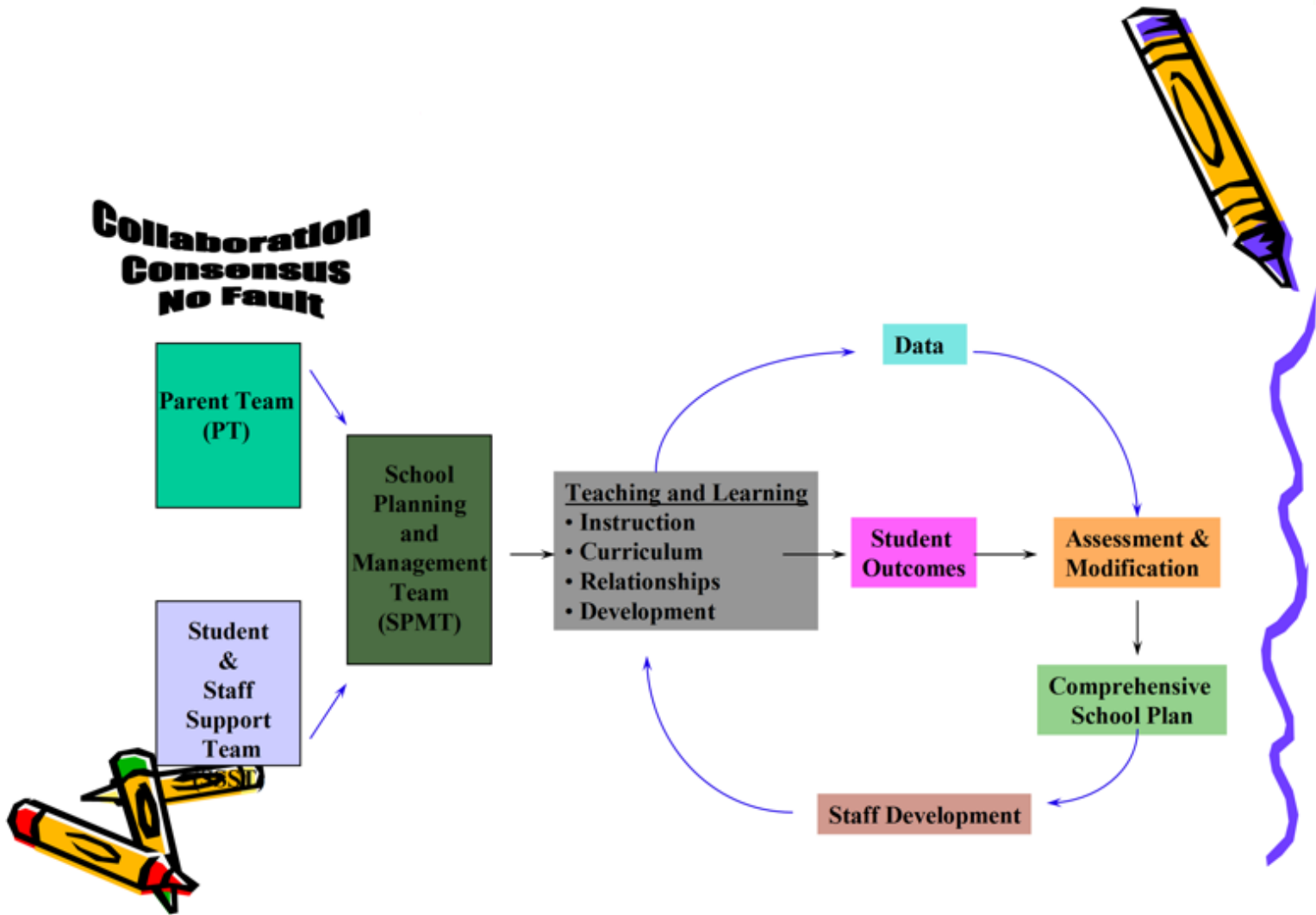
